2023 Local Scholarships with Criteria

Number of scholarships and amounts awarded may vary from information listed below.

1984 Champion Scholarship (2)

\$250.00 each- 1 male, 1 female. Students must be a member of a varsity sports team. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 to be considered. *Must apply*.

A.N. Fry Endowed Scholarship (1)

\$500.00. This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has significant financial need and is pursuing a college degree. Recipient will be chosen by the four granddaughters of Doris Fry Herner. *Must apply*.

Alf Schafer Service Learning Award (1)

\$500.00. *Must fill out separate application provided by the Schafer family in this packet.* Student must have completed the minimum number of service hours required to graduate at the time of application.

American Legion Sch-Loe-Man Post 0547 (2)

\$1,000.00 each. Must fill out <u>separate</u> application provided by the American Legion included in this packet. See cover page of application for specific criteria.

Athletic Boosters Scholarship (2)

\$1,000.00 each. 1 boy, 1 girl. Must have been a member of an athletic team or cheerleading squad with a 2.8 GPA or higher. *Must apply*.

Deb Harwood Scholarship (1)

\$500.00. To a deserving senior who shows strength in Leadership Skills. Student must show outstanding organizational qualities that involve planning activities that give back to the Monroeville Community/ Monroeville Schools. The student must be entering a postsecondary program. Winner will be chosen by the Scholarship Committee. *Must Apply*.

Deb Harwood—Cy Everman Memorial Scholarship (1)

\$500.00. Open to all graduating seniors pursuing a college degree. Special consideration will be given to any student entering the field of agriculture, but all applicants will be considered based upon your application and essay. *Must Apply*.

Deb Harwood—Wilma Everman Memorial Scholarship (1)

\$500.00. Open to all graduating seniors pursuing a college degree. Special consideration will be given to anyone entering the fields of economics, or design; however, all applicants will be considered based upon your application and essay. *Must Apply*.

F.F.A. Alumni Scholarship (1)

\$200.00. Student participating in FFA for 4 yrs., 2.0 or higher GPA and pursuing a career in the Agricultural field. *Must Apply*.

George R. Latteman Memorial Scholarship (1)

\$200.00. FFA member, 2.0 or higher GPA & pursuing a career in the Agricultural field. *Must Apply*.

Give Moore Foundation Scholarship (1)

\$500. Recipient must have a 2.00 GPA or higher. Student must be attending a post-secondary school that may include a 1-2 year trade school or adult education program. Winner is chosen by the foundation. *Must apply*.

Huron River Joint Fire District Fireman's Association Scholarship (1)

\$300.00. Must be pursuing a degree in one of the following fields: Firefighter, EMT, Nursing, Police, or any other emergency or rescue field. *Must apply*.

James C. Eberly Scholarship (1)

\$400.00. Selected by Principal, Board President, and School Counselor. A deserving graduating senior, not just one with a superior academic record. *Must apply*.

John and Sue Herner Scholarship (1)

\$2,000.00. Priority to those entering the field of Education. Selection is based upon a combination of academics, need & citizenship. If none of the current graduates are entering the field of Education, the scholarship committee will determine most deserving individual. *Must apply*.

Larry and Jane Allen Scholarship (1)

\$500. "The only limitations are the ones you place on yourself" Larry and Jane Allen believe this motto can be applied to everyone and realize the potential in every graduate. They have created this scholarship to be awarded to any deserving Senior who plans to continue their education in any postsecondary program. This could include college, trade school, technical, adult education courses, 2 year or 4 year programs. This scholarship is not limited to tuition and may be applied to anything needed to assist in their preferred training program, such as books, tools, or materials. No GPA requirement. Recipient will be chosen by the Allen Family. *Must apply*.

Music Boosters Scholarship (2)

\$250.00 each. Must apply by completing <u>separate</u> application included in this packet.

Applicant must have been an active Monroeville High School band/choir member for at least 4 years with no grade lower than a C.

Norwalk Lions Club (2)

\$1,000 each. Open to all graduating seniors pursuing a college degree. Priority will be given to those who show exceptional aptitude for service and/or teamwork and collaboration. Recipients will be chosen by the Norwalk Lions Club and will be based on your application and essay. *Must apply*.

- 4. Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.00 each. Applicants must be accepted as full-time students at an accredited college, university, trade school, or business school.
- 5. Awards will be sent directly to the recipient with each check made payable to the recipient. To receive the award, verification will be required to the effect that the student has successfully completed the first quarter/semester of the school year and is enrolled for the second.
- 6. There will be no consideration of friendship or rank of the parents/grandparents in selecting the awardees of a scholarship. Awards will be on the basis of scholarship, character, leadership, and need of the applicant.
- 7. All applications will be accompanied by the following:
 - a. A letter from the applicant with personal, specific facts as to his/her desire to continue his/her education and why financial assistance is required. This should include a list of other scholarships/grants applied for and/or received.
 - b. One (1) letter of recommendation verifying the application and giving general information and personal traits that would make the applicant a desirable recipient. This letter should ideally be from a community leader, minister, elected official, scout leader, etc.
 - c. One (1) letter of academic reference from a principal, counselor, or teacher.
- 8. If the recipient does not complete the school term for which the scholarship is awarded, due to any cause other than illness, physical injury, or military deployment, the recipient will refund the awards to the American Legion Post 547 within sixty (60) days from the date enrollment was terminated.
- 9. Scholarship applications should be turned into the Guidance Office and then will be forwarded to the Commander of the American Legion Post 547. Each application will be reviewed for <u>completeness</u> and forwarded to the American Legion Scholarship Committee. **Applications must include all materials**.
- 10. Deadline for all applications for scholarships will be observed in all instances.
- 11. Scholarship Committee: The commander of Post 547 will appoint a committee and a chairperson. The committee will be structured to ensure and include a minimum of five (5) members, with three (3) members in attendance constituting a quorum
