Industry-Recognized Credentials Review

Earning an industry-recognized credential (IRC) allows students to learn about a specific skill set or job and also demonstrates mastery of those skills. A student who earns an IRC is set-up to enter the workplace or go on to a two-year or four-year college more prepared. IRC's recognize and take into consideration a student's hard work in becoming career ready. Possessing an IRC not only helps a student prove competency and capability in a given career field, but also provides demonstration to prospective employers that the student is knowledgeable, trained and ready to carry out his or her job functions. For some students, earning an IRC can be an important step toward earning the requirements for high school graduation.

Students at MHS have the ability to earn IRC's in the following career fields: Vocational Agriculture, Construction, Education, Engineering, Health, Hospitality and Tourism and Informational Technology. Students earn points toward an IRC as they progress through a pathway of courses that integrate the content needed to successfully obtain the credentials.
