Season passes for winter sports for Monroeville High School will go on sale November 16<sup>th</sup> during school hours. Admission prices at the gate for varsity sports are \$6.00 for adults and students. Firelands Conference pre-sale student tickets will be available in the Athletic Director's office for \$3.00. These tickets are good for any conference game at any conference school. Freshman boys' basketball, junior high basketball, and junior high wrestling will be charging \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students at the gate.

- High School Winter Sports Family Pass (includes all home contests \$210.00. For immediate family (children K-12 only)
- Junior High Winter Sports Family Pass (includes all junior high contests): \$180.00. For immediate family (children K-12 only)
- Adult boys only season basketball passes: \$50.00
