Welcome to Seventh Grade Art

Seventh Grade Art is a nine-week course required of all seventh graders. This course will serve as an introduction to the study and appreciation of Art. During this course we will build upon and increase your knowledge of the elements of art; line, shape, color, texture, value, space and form. You will experience a variety of media while experimenting with various techniques. Art history and artists will be used as important references.

Quizzes/ Tests-

After the completion of each unit (element of art studied), there will be a test to assess student comprehension. This test will have written questions, vocabulary and an application section where you will demonstrate techniques that you have learned.

Homework-

On occasion, you will have homework assignments to be completed. These assignments are usually practice exercises, research for project ideas or studying for the unit tests. Late homework will follow the school homework policy in the student handbook. SOAR will be used when needed to catch up on missing or late work.

Attendance-

This is a studio course based mainly on teacher demonstrations, class discussions and studio projects; a day lost from this classroom can never be recaptured. The learning activities and demonstrations that take place in the classroom or virtually are a vital part of the teaching and learning process. Please try to be present so as not to lose out on important instruction. Remember that it is the responsibility of the student, not the teacher, to arrange for make-up work following an absence. Tardiness to individual classes will be recorded in ProgressBook daily. Tardies of 3 or more will be reported to the high school office for discipline action.
